Steps for Uploading Your Thesis Paper

- 1) Go to http://fordham.bepress.com/environ_2015/
- 2) Click on "Submit Research" link in right-hand menu.
- 3) **When asked to login, use the credentials provided by your course instructor.**
- 4) Fill out the form to add your paper to the repository, with these additions:
 - a. Author: Click the "Remove Author" () button to remove "Environmental Studies" from the author list
 - b. Date of Award: date you submit your paper
 - c. Degree type: Thesis
 - d. First Advisor: John Van Buren
 - e. Keywords: Up to six search terms, separated by commas, that describe your paper
 - f. Abstract: You can cut and paste the abstract of your paper here.
 - g. Comments: Copy the Creative Commons code (found below) and paste into the Comments field.
 - h. Any other fields in the form can be left blank or unanswered.
- 5) Be sure to upload your paper under "Upload Full Text" in the form!
- 6) Click "Submit."
- 7) On the next page, make sure all of your information is correct. If you need to make corrections, click "Revise Submission." If everything is good to go, click "Publish and Update Selected" at the bottom of the page.
